- When facing the camera, please **ensure you are looking at eye-level** into the camera when you talk (there may be a small light), and that your shoulders and head are showing clearly.
- Prepare what you are going to say, have a few dots points on hand, don't read from a script, try to relax and be yourself.
- Speak slowly and clearly.
- Wear smart casual clothing.
